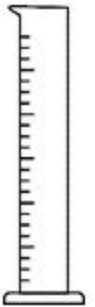

## FOOD AND DRINKS

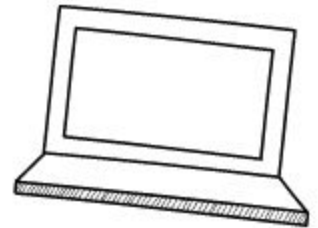
**In class:** no food or drinks.
